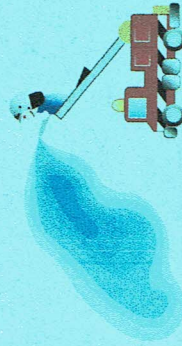

SESSIONS

Grand Officers, Committee Members, Royal Matrons, Royal Patrons, Associate Matrons and Associate Patrons are to attend all Grand Court Sessions. If you will be unable to attend the Grand Court Session, ***notify the Grand Royal Matron in writing by March 12, 2022.***

All Grand Officers are required to memorize their parts for the Informal and Ritualistic Opening and Memorial. See pages 235 to 249 in the 2014 Ritual (Green). Study all the fine print and floor work.

SESSION ATTIRE

All Honored Ladies who are Grand Officers are to wear their official gown or a colored gown of their choice (preference to Royal Purple or Royal Blue) and gloves; Sir Knights are to wear dark tuxedos during the Grand Court Session. If participating in the Necrology and Memorial Service or placing a Memorial Flower, white gowns and white gloves are to be worn by all Honored Ladies. Royal Patrons should bring their swords and only **CURRENT** Royal Matrons should bring their crowns. (see Supreme Constitution Part V, Section 1(L) page 115).
